Safety, Accessibility, and Smarter Learning — Professional Development for Educators

AI Ready Classrooms is a professional-development program that helps schools and districts move from uncertainty about artificial intelligence to consistent, defensible classroom practice. Sessions are practical, artifact-based, and designed to complement existing district policy.

The Framework

- Protect — safeguard student privacy and keep sensitive information out of AI tools.
- Prevent — reduce misuse with clear expectations, guardrails, and shared language.
- Empower — give educators usable strategies that save planning time.
- Practice — build routines teachers can repeat the next school day.

Signature Tools

- T.E.A.C.H. AI — a structured approach to responsible instructional AI use.
- The AI Use Ladder — defines what is allowed, limited, and off-limits by task.
- The Evidence Stack — documents original student thinking alongside AI-supported work.
- T.R.A.C.E. — a review routine for checking accuracy, bias, and appropriateness.

Accessibility and Inclusion

Educators apply an Access / Thinking / Evidence decision path so that AI supports access for students with disabilities and multilingual learners without replacing the thinking the standard requires.

The 90-Minute Session

- Live, facilitated workshop for teachers, instructional coaches, and administrators.
- Hands-on work with real lesson tasks, not abstract demonstrations.
- Digital professional-development completion badge for participants.
- 30-day follow-up option to review implementation and answer questions.

What Educators Leave With

- A classroom-ready AI use statement aligned to district expectations.
- Task-level guidance for when AI use is appropriate and when it is not.
- A student evidence routine that protects academic integrity.
- Accessibility supports that maintain grade-level expectations.

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Pilot Pathway

- Administrator briefing to align the program with district priorities.
- Grade-band or campus pilot session.
- Classroom implementation with shared artifacts.
- 30-day follow-up and educator feedback review.
- Scale-up plan for additional campuses or district-wide professional development.
